- 1. The Government of the Republic of Cameroun has received funding from the World Bank to finance the Transport Sector Development Project (PDST) and intends to apply part of the proceeds towards payments under the contract for the renovation work of the patrol road and reinforcement of security fence of Douala International Airport; "For this Contract, the borrower shall make payments using the direct payment disbursement method; as defined in the Guidelines of the World Bank applicable to payments under Project Investment Financing (IPF)".
- 2. The Director General of the Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority (CCAA) hereby solicits tenders under sealed envelopes from eligible bidders meeting the required qualifications to provide renovation work of the patrol road and reinforcement of security fence of Douala International Airport.
- 3. The bidding process shall be conducted by international competitive procurement through a Call for Tenders (AO) as defined in "Guidelines: Procurement of Supply, Works and Services Contracts (Other than Consultant Services) by World Bank Borrowers as part of IBRD loans and IDA Credits and Grants, January 2011 revised July 2014", and open to all bidders from eligible countries as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
- 4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain information from the Project Management Unit, E-mail: pdst.tender@ccaa.aero, located at the 20th May Boulevard, 1st floor, CAA Building, and get acquainted with tender documents from the address mentioned below, every working day, between 09am and 03pm.
- 5. The Tender Documents in *French* may be downloaded free of charge from the following CCAA website: http://www.ccaa.aero.
- 6. Tenders shall be delivered to the address below, no later than on the lectronic bidding will be authorized (cf. Provision 22.1, Section II, DPAO). Bids submitted after the expiry of the time limit will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of bidders' representatives and persons present at the address below, at 3 P.M (Local hour)

Due to COVID 19, not all bidders shall have the possibility to be present or be represented at the opening of tenders. Thus, the Contracting Authority intends to use a videoconference platform to proceed with the online opening of tenders and enable companies wishing to do so to participate remotely. A login link to the opening of tenders shall be communicated to all bidders registered in the tender register.

- 7. The tenders shall be accompanied by a statement warranty complying with the Tender File model.
- 8. Tenders shall remain valid for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days, with effect from the date of their submission.
- 9. The qualification requirements are as follows:
 - (i) The Bidder shall prove that he has liquid assets or access to unencumbered assets or credit lines, etc. other than the possible advance payment, whose amounts are sufficient to meet the cash requirements necessary for the performance of the work under this Call for Tenders, to the amount of 4,000,000 US\$, i.e. approximately 2,000,000 000 XAF, free from its other commitments;
 - (ii) Submission of audited balance sheets or, if not required by regulations of the Applicant's country, other financial statements acceptable to the Contracting Authority over the **05 past years (2015-2019)** proving the current solvency and long-term profitability of the Bidder.
 - (iii) Having achieved a minimum average annual turnover of at least Twelve million (12,000,000) US\$, i.e. approximately 06 Billion XAF, calculated as follows: total amount of mandated payments received for current and/or completed contracts over the 05 past years (2015-2019) divided by 5.
 - (iv) Having participated as main contractor, member of an assembly group, or sub-contractor in at least two road construction contracts of a minimum amount of five billion CFAF Exclusive of Tax each.
 - Contracts presented under this criteria shall be similar (similarity will be established on the basis of physical size, complexity of construction methods/technologies and/or other characteristics described in the technical specifications) and performed over the past five (05) years from the 1st January 2015 until the deadline for satisfactory submission of tenders and substantially completed (this refers to work completed at 80% or more works provided for in the Contract).
 - (v) Provide evidence of ownership of the necessary materials and equipment referred to in Section III of the Tender File (Evaluation and Qualification Criteria) available for consultation at the Procurement Service of the PDST-Air Component.

(vi) Provide evidence of having at its disposal a personnel with the experience required in the Tender File (Section III, Evaluation and Qualification Criteria) available for consultation at the Procurement Service of the PDST-Air Component.

No margin of preference shall be granted to eligible bidders.
